STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to a State Geologist.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 49, § 53, amended. Section 53 of chapter 49 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 53. Compensation; expenses. The state geologist shall receive an annual salary of \$1000 for each of the fiscal years ending June 30, $\frac{1938}{1940}$ and June 30, $\frac{1939}{1941}$ and such expenses as may be approved by the governor and council. He may employ assistants, purchase material and publish documents for which the state shall pay out of funds provided for the department.'
