AN ACT Relating to Exemption from Taxation

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 13, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 76 of the public laws of 1935, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following sub-paragraph to be numbered XV:

'XV. Property in the possession of a common carrier while in interstate transportation or held en route awaiting further transportation to the destination named in a through bill of lading.'
