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**AN ACT Relative to the Sale of Deer.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 95, amended.** Section 95 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 95. Sale of deer or parts thereof.** No person shall at any time buy, sell or offer for sale or barter any deer or part thereof except that the heads and hides thereof may be sold to any properly licensed taxidermist or dealer in deer skins and heads as provided in sections 92 and 93.'
