STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend An Act Relating to Unemployment Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 192, § 14, amended. Paragraph (a) of section 14 of chapter 192 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 14. Collection of contributions. (a) Interest on past-due contributions. Contributions unpaid on the date on which they are due and payable as prescribed by the commission, shall bear interest at the rate of I per cent per month from and after such date until payment plus accrued interest is received by the commission; provided however, in such cases of delinquency as are shown to the satisfaction of the commission to arise from reasonable questions of liability under the terms of section 19 (f) or (g), the commission may, in its discretion, abate not exceeding 75 per cent of the interest herein imposed. Interest collected pursuant to this subsection shall be paid into the unemployment compensation fund.'
