STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Licenses for Dispensing Victuals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 36 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 4. License fee and record. Every person licensed shall pay to the treasurer for the use of the town a fee in such sum as the town may by ordinance or by-law prescribe and such ordinance or by-law may establish classifications with respect to such licenses and fees. The clerk shall make a record of all licenses granted.'
