## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Notice to Parties in Interest in Probate Proceedings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 75, additional. Chapter 75 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 53 and to read as follows:

'Sec. 53. Notice required to attorneys where general appearance entered. Any attorney at law representing a party in interest in any estate or matter pending before the probate court may enter a general appearance with the register of probate. After such general appearance has been entered no action shall be taken by said court in connection with said estate or matter pending until said attorney has agreed thereto or been given a reasonable opportunity to be heard thereon by the court.'
