# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relative to Possession of Firearms in the Night-time.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 46-C, additional.** Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 46-C, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 46-C. Possession of firearms in the night-time. No person shall have in or on any automobile or other vehicle, in the night, while upon any road or in the fields or forests, in any area frequented by game, any rifle or shotgun unless the same be securely wrapped or in a case.'
