## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

## AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Belfast Municipal Court in Regard to Name of Court and as to Who Shall Provide a Suitable Room in Which to Hold Said Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 254, § 1, amended. Section 1, of chapter 254 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by section 1 of chapter 126 of the private and special laws of 1921, and by chapter 104 of the private and special laws of 1925 is hereby further amended by striking out the first complete sentence in section 1, of chapter 104, and inserting in place thereof the following: 'A municipal court shall be and hereby is established in and for the county of Waldo to be located in the city of Belfast within and for said county, which shall be denominated Waldo County Municipal Court and which shall be a court of record, have a seal, and consist of one judge, who shall be an attorney-at-law and reside in Belfast; said judge to be appointed and commissioned as in the Constitution provided'.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 254, § 5, amended. The first paragraph of section 5 of chapter 254 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read as follows: 'The city of Belfast County of Waldo shall have

power and it shall be its the duty of the county commissioners for said county to provide a suitable room in the county building in which to hold said court for the use of said judge, and to furnish a seal for said Court'.
