STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Sheriff of Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 16 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$1800; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$1200; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$2000; for clerks in the office of sheriff, six hundred dollars \$900.'
