IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Lien on Potatoes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 105, additional. Chapter 105 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 55-A, and to read as follows:

‘Sec. 55-A. **Lien on potatoes, for harvesting. Whoever labors in harvesting potatoes has a lien on all potatoes harvested by him and his co-laborers for the amount due for his personal services, which takes precedence over all claims except liens reserved to the state, and continues for 30 days after such harvesting is completed, and may be enforced by attachment.**’
