AN ACT Making Illegal Contracts to Remit Certain Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Unlawful contracts to remit or abate taxes. It shall be unlawful for any town or taxing entity to agree or contract for any valuable consideration to it made or rendered, or to be made or rendered, to remit or abate in whole or in part any taxes to be assessed against any person or legal entity, or to pay for such consideration a sum of money equal to, or in any way, in whole or in part, measured by, the amount of said taxes.
