STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide Compensation for Indian Representatives to the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Compensation for representatives of Indian tribes. Each representative to the legislature from the Penobscot tribe of Indians and the Passama-quoddy tribe of Indians shall receive the same compensation, payable at the same times, as is paid each member of the senate and house of representatives under the provisions of law.
