AN ACT Relating to Old Age Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1937, c. 105, Title II, § 4, ¶ (a), amended. Paragraph (a) of section 4 of Title II of chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1937 is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘(a) Is ~~65~~ 60 years of age or more.’

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1937, c. 105, Title II, § 12, repealed. Section 12 of Title II of chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1937 is hereby repealed.
