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**Knox Memorial Association, Inc., appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Knox Memorial Association, Inc., the sum of \$1000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1940, and the sum of \$1000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941, to aid in the support and maintenance of "Montpelier," replica of the home of Major General Henry Knox, located at Thomaston, Maine. By this appropriation it is not understood to encourage future financial aid.
