AN ACT Permitting Sunday Hunting of Game Birds and Foxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 44, amended. Section 44 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 44. Sunday closed to hunting of birds and animals; exception. Sunday is a closed season, on which it is not lawful to hunt any wild animals or wild birds of any kind, **except for game birds and foxes.'**
