## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

### AN ACT Relative to Errors in Records, Tax Lists, Descriptions of Real Estate, and Returns, how Amended.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 5, § 10, amended.** Section 10 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 10. Errors in records, tax lists, and returns, how amended. When omissions or errors exist in the records, or tax lists, descriptions of real estate or as to location of personal property, of a town or school district, or in returns of warrants for meetings thereof, they shall be amended, on oath, according to the fact, while in or after he ceases to be in office, by the officer whose duty it was to make them correctly, or by his successor or successors in office. If the original warrant is lost or destroyed, the return, or an amendment of it, may be made upon a copy thereof.'
