STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to the Taking of Hellgrammites.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section to be numbered 29-A, and to read as follows:

'Sec. 29-A. Taking of helgrammites. No person shall take, buy or transport any hellgrammites for use beyond the limits of this state.'
