IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Pauper Expense.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 91, as amended, repealed. Chapter 91 of the public laws of 1935, as amended by chapter 115 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby repealed.
