STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Unlawful Taking of Aircraft.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 139, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 139 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Unlawful taking and use of boats, vehicles, aircraft or draft animals; penalty; limitation. Whoever in any other case, wilfully and mischievously takes or uses any boat, or vehicle, aeroplane or other aircraft, or takes, drives, rides, or uses any horse, ox, or other draft animal, the property of another, without the consent of the owner, or person having the legal custody, care and control thereof; or whoever hires with intent to and does so use or drive any horse, ox, or other draft animal in excess of any contract made with the owner or keeper thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300, or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months; but this and the preceding section do not apply to any case of taking the property of another with intent to steal the same, or when such property is taken under a claim of right, or with the presumed consent of the owner or person having the legal control thereof.'
