RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Armstrong Brook.

Fishing in Armstrong brook, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Armstrong brook in Stockholm, New Sweden, T. 16, R. 4, T. 17, R. 4, W. E. L. S., and all tributaries, to fishing under the general law.
