IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hairdressing Apprentices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Hairdressing apprentices. All acts or patts of acts relating to "apprentices" as defined in paragraph numbered 4 in section 1 of chapter 112 of the public laws of 1935 are hereby amended or repealed in so far as they relate to "apprentices" as therein defined.
