AN ACT to Authorize the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Lands to the Aroostook Trust Company of Caribou, Maine, as Trustee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Forest commissioner authorized to sell certain land. The forest commissioner is hereby authorized to sell and convey to the Aroostook Trust Company, a banking corporation organized under the laws of the state of Maine, the following described lands sold by the state of Maine for non-payment of taxes for the year 1932 to 1938, inclusive, upon the payment to the state of the amount of all unpaid taxes and accrued interest. The lands are situated in Aroostook county, and described as follows:

The following described pieces of land situated in township number 17 range 5, county and state aforesaid, being lot 288 containing 20 acres more or less, being same deeded to Alphonse Bouchard by Charles Bouchard, deed recorded in the Aroostook registry of deeds, northern district, vol. 69, page 45.

Also the western half of lot number 293 containing 46½ acres more or less according to survey of A. E. Hanson made in 1893, being same deeded to said Alphonse Bouchard by Louis Tardiff by deed dated March 31, 1919, recorded in aforesaid registry of deeds, vol. 89, page 374.
