RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Land in Washington County to Robert Bernard, Jr., of New York.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner as land agent, be and hereby is, authorized to convey to Robert Bernard, Jr., of New York, the interest of the state in 1 acre lot of land with buildings thereon, in T. 9, R. 4, N. B. P. P. (formerly Forest City), Washington county, for the sum of \$37.10.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This land, reputed to be owned by Mrs. Annie E. Newall of Houlton, was acquired by the forest commissioner in behalf of the state in 1937 for 1935 taxes. Mr. Bernard is desirous of obtaining this lot by paying the taxes in arrears. The taxes in arrears with interest and advertising to April 1, 1939 amount to \$37.10. Check for this amount is now in the hands of the state tax assessor.
