## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Repealing the Law Relating to the Policeman for the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1899, c. 49, repealed. Chapter 49 of the private and special laws of 1899 as amended by chapter 108 of the private and special laws of 1915, is hereby repealed.
