RESOLVE, Relating to a Rearing Station for Bass at the Head of Grand Lake, Aroostook County.

Rearing station for bass, established. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to establish a rearing station for bass at the head of Grand lake, Aroostook county; and the expenses of building said station and the cost of maintaining same shall be paid from the funds appropriated for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game.
