AN ACT Amending the Unemployment Compensation Law Relative to Liability of Employers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1935, c. 192, § 7, amended. Subsection (a) of section 7 of chapter 192 of the public laws of 1935 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered (3) and to read as follows:

‘(3) Any employing unit which becomes an employer by virtue of the terms of section 19 (f) (2) or (3) shall be liable for unpaid contributions upon remuneration paid to employees of the acquired employing unit during the calendar year in which such acquisition occurred.’
