IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Mount Desert Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Cost of lights on Mount Desert Bridge to be paid by the state. The maintenance of the lights on Mount Desert Bridge, so-called, shall be under the direction of the state; and shall be paid for by the state from the general highway fund.

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed in so far as they relate to this act.
