**AN ACT Requiring the State to Construct Sidewalks along State
Highways.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Construction of sidewalks along state highways. Wherever the state highway commission has laid out, constructed and maintained, and shall lay out, construct and maintain state and state aid highways as authorized by section 8 of chapter 28 of the revised statutes, in case there are no existing sidewalks paralleling such highways, the state highway commission, at the expense of the state, shall cause the construction of such sidewalks in the compact or built-up portions of any city, town or village which shall be construed to mean the territory of such city, town or village where the dwelling houses are situated less than 150 feet apart for a distance of at least $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile.
