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**AN ACT to Clarify the Meaning of the Law Regulating Mutual Insurance  
Companies.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 60, § 33, amended.** Section 33 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 33. Insurance by mutual companies regulated.** Domestic mutual fire insurance companies may make insurance for a term, not exceeding 7 years, on dwelling-houses, stores, shops and other buildings, and on household furniture, merchandise and other property, against loss or damage by fire originating in any cause other than by design on the part of the assured, and for such other purposes as are now or may be hereafter enumerated in section 55 of this chapter.'
