AN ACT Relating to Transportation of Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 68, amended. Section 68 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph thereof the following: ‘; but any citizen who is the owner of any premises upon which any deer has legally been killed by him may transport said deer to his own home without the purchase of such tag.’
