STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Oxford County Waters.

Fishing in certain Oxford county waters, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that it shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch, and kill, at any time, any trout less than 9 inches in length, in Hall's pond, in the towns of Paris and Hebron, Hutchinson pond in the township of Albany, Sand pond, Pennesseewassee lake, Hobb's pond or Little Pennesseewassee lake, in the town of Norway, in the county of Oxford.
