RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Hobb's Pond or Little Pennesseewassee

Lake in Oxford County.

Fishing in Hobb's pond or Little Pennesseewassee lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Hobb's pond or Little Pennesseewassee lake in Norway, in the county of Oxford, to ice fishing during the months of February and March of each year under the general laws of the state.
