RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Oxford County Waters.

Fishing in certain Oxford County waters regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation that it shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, or kill more than 5 trout in all, in any one day in the waters of Hall's Pond, in the towns of Paris and Hebron, Hutchinson Pond in the township of Albany, Sand Pond, Lake Pennesseewassee, or Hobb's Pond or Little Pennesseewassee Lake, in Norway, in said county of Oxford.
