RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Franklin County Waters.

Fishing in Certain Franklin County Waters; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation making it unlawful for any person to have in possession more than 6 fish or 5 pounds, taken from any or all of the following waters: Kennebago Lake, Kennebago Lake, Little, Kennebago Stream, Little, Seven Ponds Stream, Johns Pond, Flatiron Pond and Blanchard Pond, all situated in the county of Franklin.
