**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Baker Pond in Township 5, Range 6,
B. K. P., W. K. R.**

Fishing in Baker pond; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Baker pond in township 5, range 6, B. K. P., W. K. R. to fly fishing, excepting Sunday, with a daily bag limit of 10 fish or 5 pounds per person per day.
