IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Permitting a Wharf and Boathouse to be Built on Pleasant Lake in Casco, Maine.

Wharf and boathouse on Pleasant Lake, authorized. Resolved: That Merritt B. Gay, of Casco, be and hereby is, authorized to build a wharf or wharves on the north side of causeway at the south end of Pleasant Lake in Casco, in a space beginning at the east side of the Lily Brook bridge, socalled, and extending easterly 370 feet, also to erect a building or buildings in the nature of a boathouse on the south side of said causeway beginning at the east side of Lily Brook bridge, so-called, and extending easterly a distance of 320 feet.
