**AN ACT Permitting the Trustees of the Henry W. Clary Memorial Trust
Fund to Reimburse Chester A. Boynton.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Erroneous appraisal of Henry W. Clary estate, clarified. The trustees of the Henry W. Clary estate are hereby authorized to reimburse Chester A. Boynton, of North Whitefield for damages caused to him by an erroneous appraisal of the Henry W. Clary estate.

Sec. 2. Damages; how decided. The judge of the probate court of the county of Lincoln shall act as a referee, or shall appoint a suitable person to act as a referee, and shall appoint the time and place for a hearing on the facts, and decide the amount of damages which the said Chester A. Boynton has suffered in the case. All expenses incident to this reference shall be borne by Chester A. Boynton. The judgment of the referee shall be final.
