STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT To Confirm, Ratify and Validate the Incorporation of the First Baptist Church of Yarmouth, Maine, and to Increase its Powers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Organization of corporation validated. The acts and proceedings of The First Baptist Church of Yarmouth, Maine, in respect of organizing a corporation in March, 1915, under the provisions of chapter 57 of the revised statutes of 1903, in so far as the same may be defective in form or substance are hereby made valid and of full legal effect and said The First Baptist Church of Yarmouth, Maine, is declared to be a corporation in accordance with the provisions of said chapter 57 of the revised statutes of 1903 and all succeeding acts, and acts additional thereto and amendatory thereof.
- Sec. 2. Powers. Said The First Baptist Church of Yarmouth, Maine, is hereby granted all powers, rights, privileges, franchises and immunities under the provisions of sections 24 to 32, inclusive, of chapter 20 of the revised statutes of 1930, and acts additional thereto and amendatory thereof, so far as the same are not inconsistent with chapter 70 of the revised statutes of 1930 which shall control and govern in case of conflict.
