IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to the Livermore Falls Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1907, c. 390, § 14, amended. Section 14 of chapter 390 of the private and special laws of 1907 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

‘The trustees of said water district shall not borrow a total of more than \$10,000 without the majority vote of the legal voters of said district in a meeting duly called for that purpose.’

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1907, c. 390, additional. Chapter 390 of the private and special laws of 1907 is hereby amended by adding a new section to be numbered 20, and to read as follows :

‘Sec. 20. Meetings. Meetings of the legal voters of said district may be called by the trustees of said water district on their own motion, and shall be called by said trustees on the written petition therefor signed by not less than 10 legal voters of said district, by giving 7 days public notice thereof by posting in 3 public and conspicuous places in said district notices of the time, place and purpose of said meeting.’
