S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Deeds, in the
County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The last paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘York county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~three thousand dollars~~ \$4000; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$2080; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$1750.’

Sec. 2. Limitation. This act shall be in effect for 2 years only from the effective date of this act.
