AN ACT Exempting Life Insurance Policies from Old Age Assistance Requirements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1937, c. 105, Title II, § 4, amended. Paragraph lettered (b) of section 4 of Title II of chapter 105 of the private and special laws of 1937 is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘(b) Has not sufficient income or other resources to provide a reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health; **provided, however, that life insurance policies held by either the applicant or his or her spouse shall not be considered as a resource, and the ownership of which shall not be considered a reason for refusing assistance;**’
