RESOLVE, for Surveying the Outlet of Moosehead Lake.

Moosehead lake; surveying of. Resolved: That the sum of \$2000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be taken from the general funds of the State, to be expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game for the purpose of making a survey of the outlet of Moosehead lake into the Kennebec river, to determine the feasibility of installing a screen therein.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The fishing in Moosehead lake constitutes one of the greatest recreational features of the state, and the people interested therein feel that this body of water suffers a great loss of fish annually through lack of a screen at its outlet into the Kennebec river.
