RESOLVE, in Favor of Samuel J. Dana, Representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians.

Samuel J. Dana, appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Samuel J. Dana, representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians at the 89th legislature, the sum of \$200 for attendance and \$44 for mileage; said sums to be paid from the appropriation for legislative expenses.
