S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Moro Plantation.

Moro Plantation; appropriated for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$1500, to be taken from the general highway fund, to aid Moro plantation in repairing route 11 between Hall corner and Kilgore corner (so-called) beginning where the 1938 state aid road stops, and continuing to a point where previous state aid road begins, provided, however, that said sum will not be available, unless Moro plantation shall apply their regular state aid money to match the aforesaid sum in repairing this stretch of road.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is on route 11, leading from Fort Kent to Bangor. It has been all built, but a small stretch, which is in terrible condition. The road is tarred on both ends of this stretch, and greatly travelled by tourists, who enjoy woods scenery, and also by the farmers who truck their potatoes to market, and water shipping points.
