RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Harriman Pond.

Fishing in Harriman pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all ice fishing Harriman pond in the town of Dedham, county of Hancock, for 3 years.
