RESOLVE, Regulating the Trapping of Muskrats in Runnells Brook.

Trapping of muskrats in Runnells brook; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Runnells brook, in the town of Whiting, and the tributaries thereto, to the taking of muskrats and mink for a period of 6 years.
