**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Fry Pan Pond in Square Town,
Somerset County.**

Fishing in Fry Pan pond; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation reducing the daily bag limit on game fish taken from Fry Pan pond, in Square Town, Somerset county, to 15 fish per person per day.
