IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Round Pond, in Square Town, Somerset County.

Fishing in Round Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation reducing the daily bag limit on game fish taken from Round Pond, in Square Town, Somerset county, to 15 fish per person per day.
