IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Game Preserve in Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 90, amended. Section 90 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto, after the second paragraph thereof, the following:

'Patten: No person shall at any time hunt, chase, catch, kill or destroy any wild bird or wild animal within the following named territory; on land belonging to the Seboeis bridge corporation in Patten.'
