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AN ACT Relative to Trapping on Game Preserves.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 91, amended.** Section 91 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**‘Sec. 91. Hunting or possession of firearms within the limits of game preserves forbidden; exceptions.** No person shall at any time hunt, chase, catch, kill or destroy any wild birds or wild animals or have in possession firearms of any description within the limits of any game preserve or closed territory except as provided in this chapter, and except that the commissioner is hereby authorized to **regulate the trapping of fur-bearing animals thereon and to** use such means as may seem necessary to exterminate vermin of any description in all game preserves and sanctuaries and in any other localities where damage is being done.’
